I am requesting funding for the Kane Scott Community Living Center Critical Infrastructure and Equipment Modernization Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Allegheny County, located at 436 Grant Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15219.

The project will address essential upgrades to aging systems that directly affect resident safety, operational reliability, and long-term sustainability at Allegheny County's 311-bed skilled nursing facility in Scott Township. Work includes replacement of the roof, windows, HVAC systems, commercial hot water tanks, boilers, and critical kitchen equipment used to support daily residential and clinical care.

The project would be a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it will reduce emergency repairs, improve energy performance, and ensure uninterrupted delivery of skilled nursing, memory care, rehabilitation, and other services for older adults and medically complex residents across Allegheny County.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. §201 et seq.).
