Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Kennedy Township Sanitary Pump Stations Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Kennedy Township, located at 340 Forest Grove Road, Coraopolis, Pennsylvania 15108.

The funding would involve the comprehensive renovation and refurbishment of 10 sanitary pump stations that are currently 52 years old and have exceeded their useful design life. At over five decades old, the mechanical and electrical components are failing, leading to increased maintenance costs and heightened risks of Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs). The project would be a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it will provide critical infrastructure repairs, prevent costly emergency repairs and protect local water quality. This is required by the ALCOSAN Consent Decree.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 221 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1301) regarding the management of municipal combined sewer flows and sanitary sewer overflows.
