Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Midland Beaver Road Restoration project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, District 11, located at 45 Thoms Run Road Bridgeville, Pennsylvania 15017.

The funding would be used for a mill and resurface of the existing asphalt pavement, structure preservation work, base repairs, updates to guide rail, drainage, ADA curb ramps, traffic signals, signing, pavement markings, delineation, and other miscellaneous construction.

The project will be a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it will provide a benefit to the surrounding communities of Beaver, Midland, Industry, and Shippingport, by increasing the safety of the traveling public through the corridor and by providing a smooth, long lasting pavement surface. Safety will be enhanced by better capturing water with the drainage improvements, the upgrading of guide rail and barrier, the installation of new pavement markings, signage, and delineation. Accessibility will be improved by the installation of ADA curb ramps. Traffic signal upgrades will enhance the flow of both vehicles and pedestrians at intersections within the corridor.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC § 133.
