I am requesting funding for the Police Station Addition Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Northern Regional Police Department, located at 230 Pearce Mill Road, Wexford, Pennsylvania 15090.

The funding would expand the existing police department building with a 4,000 square foot addition. The facility must support the growth in staff, vehicles, evidence volume, training needs, and secure operations while improving safety, functionality, and compliance. The project is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because Northern Regional Police Department provides policing for six rural communities in northern Allegheny County and southern Butler County. This service is essential to community safety in Pine Township, Marshall Township, Bradford Woods Borough, Richland Township, and Seven Fields Borough. This grant project will benefit all residents and businesses in these communities.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a).
