Dear Senators Fetterman and McCormick,

We write as members of the Pennsylvania Delegation to the U.S. House of Representatives. Our message is simple: we urge you to oppose any legislation that provides funding to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) without first securing meaningful, enforceable reforms to U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) and related DHS agency activity.

The DHS Fiscal Year 2026 Appropriations bill in front of the Senate for consideration this week does not include such reforms, and we urge you to oppose it. We voted against this bill last week and ask that you do the same. Funding without adequate reform risks endorsing current approaches that undermine public safety and due process, erode American liberties, and weaken public trust.

We urge you to stand with us in opposing any DHS funding bill that does not include critical reforms. We look forward to working together to advance legislation that both keeps our nation secure and upholds our fundamental values.


