I am requesting funding for the Ross Township Police Department Body-Worn Camera/Fleet Video Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Ross Township Police Department, located at 1000 Ross Municipal Dr, Pittsburgh, PA 15237. The funding would be used to replace existing (end of life) Body-worn Cameras and Fleet Video. Additionally, they are different systems which do not integrate.
